Vigor Yang, Editor-in-Chief of the *JANNAF Journal of Propulsion and Energetics*, has announced that the Journal received a commitment of financial sponsorship from Space Explorations Technology Corporation – SpaceX – effective 31 January 2010.

SpaceX is a leader among small commercial U.S. space companies. With its main facility located in Hawthorne, California, SpaceX has developed its own launch vehicles — the Falcon 1 and Falcon 9 — and been awarded COTS funding by NASA to demonstrate delivery and return of cargo to the International Space Station.

SpaceX is the first commercial enterprise to partner with the limited-distribution *JANNAF Journal of Propulsion and Energetics*, now in its third year of publication. The SpaceX logo will be displayed on the back cover of the Journal, Volume 3, due for release in May.
