Most attendees wear business or business casual attire. Cold temperatures are possible, and there could be some snow, so if you plan to venture out during free time, be sure to pack accordingly.

On-Site Registration / Check-in

The JANNAF Registration and Security Desks will be located on the 2nd floor of the hotel. **You must present a Government-issued photo ID at registration to receive your badge and materials.** *If you are missing one or both of the required registration steps, be sure your registration steps are complete prior to arriving at the JANNAF registration area. We will need to verify your registration before giving you your badge and materials.*

The JANNAF Registration desk will be open the following days and times:

- Sunday from 5:00pm - 7:00pm
- Monday through Friday from 7:00am - 5:00pm

Security

The overall classification of this meeting is SECRET. There will be security guards stationed strategically to ensure that only qualified JANNAF attendees enter our security perimeter. **Please be sure to wear your JANNAF badge at all times while attending JANNAF sessions, meetings and events, including the Networking Reception on Wednesday, and when boarding the shuttle bus for classified sessions.**

If your registration to attend classified sessions has been **confirmed**, please note that the [shuttle bus schedule](#) has been updated on the meeting website. Only those approved to attend classified sessions will be permitted to board the bus. The schedule indicates the location for loading/unloading at the hotel. Remember, driving to the UTNG is **not** an option.
